2/4: Social Media Set-up meeting. Office Manager Chapman, Trustee Maviglio and I met to set-up our Social Media pages.

2/4: USACE Levee Safety meeting. I attended this online meeting to hear a USACE staff presentation to the Safety Oversight Group on the risk assessment for the AR North-NEMDC- Arcade Creek South levee system.

2/9: River District Levee Access meeting. Trustee Holloway and I met with Devin Strecker and Greta Lacin from the River District to discuss potential improvement plans for levee access points.

2/12: Levee Maintenance Inter-Agency Workshop. I attended this workshop hosted by the US Army Corps of Engineers, DWR and the Central Valley Flood Protection Board to discuss a variety of topics relating to Levee Maintenance.

2/13: American River Flood Control District Board of Trustees meeting. The Board met in regular session. The agenda items consisted of nominations for the LAFCo Special District Representatives, and two CVFPB Encroachment Permits for a UPRR Trestle replacement and a Fiber Optic Communications line.

2/17: MBK Coordination meeting. I met with Pro Mitra from MBK Engineers to work on responses to the USACE Routine Inspection Report for the American River North Levee, NEMDC, Arcade Creek South Levee System.
