

## General Manager's Meeting Summary

### December 2025

**12/3: Regional Water Quality Control Board Levee Tour.** Superintendent Morris, and I provided a levee tour along Arcade Creek to the Central Valley RWQCB. RWQCB staff were alerted to potential water hazards from homeless encampments within Arcade Creek and wanted to see the conditions first hand. Thanks to a very diligent and aggressive program of camp removal by ARFCD this summer and fall, there was only one small camp on ARFCD owned parcels within Arcade Creek and the levees were immaculate.

**12/4: Sac Horseman's Association Ueda Parkway meeting.** I attended this meeting to discuss the site conditions and management of the Ueda Parkway. Representatives from City and County law enforcement, City Department of Community Response, RD 1000, and the River City Waterway Alliance were present to discuss their role in the management of human activity within the North Area creeks and streams.

**12/12: Senator Ashby Waterways Encampments meeting.** I attended this web meeting to hear discussions from State agencies on their perceived role in managing encampments within the waterways.

**12/12: American River Flood Control District Board of Trustees meeting.** The Board met in regular session. The agenda items consisted of a declaration of surplus equipment for the Bomford mower and the JD loader attachment, and approval of the 2025 District Newsletter.
