

General Manager's Meeting Summary

September 2025

9/2: Annual Steelhead Creek Clean-up Planning meeting. The Central Valley Water Quality Control Board hosted this planning meeting for the annual encampment debris clean-up of Steelhead Creek. The clean-up is scheduled to begin on September 29th.

9/4: DWR Local Maintaining Agency Coordination meeting. I attended this meeting to discuss the status of DWR inspections, USACE projects, and State grant programs. Funding for the Flood Maintenance Assistance Program (FMAP) is uncertain for the current year and going forward. The Central Valley Flood Protection Board Enforcement Section provided a status update on enforcement cases.

9/4: North Area Encampments meeting. I attended this meeting hosted by the Ben Ali Neighborhood Association to discuss the site conditions and management of the Ueda Parkway. Representatives from City and County law enforcement and the River City Waterway Alliance were present to discuss their role in the management of human activity within the North Area creeks and streams.

9/5: County Parks Levee Pipe Repair Site Visit. I met in the field with staff from MBK Engineers and the County of Sacramento to locate the alignment for a leaking water line crossing the American River South Levee at the Watt Avenue Access.

9/9: ARFCD Public Outreach Committee Meeting with Pete Spaulding. The Public Outreach Committee met with Mr. Pete Spaulding to learn about his group, American River Trees, and their position on the proposed USACE bank protection project Contract 3B near Larchmont Park.

9/12: American River Flood Control District Board of Trustees meeting. The Board met in regular session. The agenda item consisted of an encroachment permit application for Sacramento County Parks to repair a leaking water line in the levee near Watt Avenue.

8/17: Central Valley Flood Control Association Board of Directors meeting. I attended this meeting to discuss regional levee operations and maintenance topics. Items of discussion included the upcoming Flood Forum, a legislation update, and State funding.

9/30: City of Sacramento Highwater Jamboree Planning meeting. I attended this meeting to help plan the annual Highwater Jamboree to be held at the North Natomas Community Park. This year's event will be on October 18th.
